- Both online and paper/pencil test administration options offered
- Wide assortment of available scores, including a Lexile[®] score for determining a student's reading level



The Cognitive Abilities Test™ (CogAT®) Form 7 measures students' verbal, quantitative, and nonverbal reasoning abilities and assists educators and parents in determining effective instructional strategies.

- Available for Grades K-12
- Easily administered in three testing sessions (total times vary from 1.5 to 2.5 hours)
- Practice tests (through 6th grade) available at no cost on the **DataManager** website
